This funding will be used to

- Increase the A-C Levels of Achievement (differentiated per cohort) by 2% or more in the learning area of English. **(Whole School English 80%)**
- Increase Year 3 and Year 5 Mean Scale Score and Upper 2 Bands Data with a focus on Reading and Writing
- Build the staff capacity, capability, skills and confidence through embedding a coaching framework for Tier 1 and Tier 2 support for Learning and Behaviour
- To support 90% of teachers to feel confident in using Essential Skills of Classroom Management to manage minor behaviours in a classroom and non classroom setting
- Improve all Behaviour Management Data, including SOS, SDA and major/minor incidents
- Meet attendance target of 85% whole school attendance

Our initiatives include

- Embed instructional and gradual release coaching models to enact the school-wide pedagogical framework including a focus on Teaching with a Literacy Focus and inclusion strategies using co-teaching across the English learning area
- Teacher engagement in understanding of, and how to meet the individual needs of students at the pre planning case management meetings utilising the Effective Teaching and Learning graphic
- Teacher engagement in Instructional Coaching Cycle opportunities for Oral language and Phonemic Awareness in consultation with HOD:SS and SLP
- Investing in instructional leadership to support observation and feedback structures
- Review and embed whole school approach to the explicit teaching of reading.
- Implementation of initial phase of Positive Behaviour for Learning through explicitly teaching the school rules and expectations, incorporating Social Emotional Social Skills lessons
- Track, monitor and support whole school attendance and provide support for at risk students

Our school will improve student outcomes by

- Purchase of additional Speech Language Pathologist (SLP) time to collaborate with Head of Department: Student Services (HoD: SS). \$42 078
- Purchase 0.8 FTE Head of Department: Teaching and Learning (HoD: T&L) for implementation of Instructional Coaching Cycles to all teaching staff \$109 055
- Purchase of attendance support staff to provide support for at risk students \$21 036
